

Leesport Pool 2020 Conduct & Safety Policies

Conduct Policies:

Pool members or guest of members are required to refrain from:

- Disruptive behavior including but not limited to the use of profanity, obscenity, excessive physical contact, inappropriate displays of affection or behaving in a way disruptive to the normal and orderly operation of the pool or pool grounds.
- Wearing bathing attire considered to be inappropriate for a family environment or use of the pool facilities. Proper bathing attire must be worn at all times.
- Verbal abuse or harassment of the pool manager, assistant pool manager, life guards or other pool members.
- Theft of Leesport Pool property, or property belonging to other pool members.
- Possession or use of tobacco by minors under the age of 18 on Leesport Pool property.
- Smoking inside the fenced area of the pool and the pool entrance is prohibited.
- Destroying or defacing Leesport Pool property or property belonging to other pool members.
- Fighting (physical contact meant to do harm to a pool employee or other pool member).
- Diving in shallow areas.
- Socializing with lifeguards or front gate staff while on duty.

Public Health & Safety Policies:

- All patrons must sign a COVID-19 liability waiver upon first entry. The waiver will be valid for the 2020 season
- All children age 3 or under or ANY swimmer not toilet trained MUST wear a swim diaper in the pools. Disposable diapers are prohibited.
- Admission to the pool may be refused to any person having an open wound or any communicable disease.
- Patrons should not enter the pool facility if they show any symptoms of COVID-19, including fever, cough or difficulty breathing
- The facility will follow the guidelines of U.S. Center for Disease Control with regard to fecal incidents, which may require clearing or closing the pool for disinfection.
- The pool area will be cleared for 30 minutes following the sound of thunder or sight of lightning. In the event of a pool closing due to weather conditions, all patrons must leave the facility entirely.

All members are required to review, acknowledge, and adhere to the Pool Opening Safety Plan per the CDC guidelines and the liability waiver.
