2020 MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

- Membership cards may be picked up at the pool after opening day.
- **Family memberships:**
 - include 2 adults and up to 4 children under 18.
 - Additional immediate family can be added for an additional \$25.00 each.
 - Babysat children may not be included within a sitter's family membership.
- Seniors (60+) are free with a valid ID.
- **Pool Opens:** July 10th **Pool Hours:** 12:00 - 7:00pm weather permitting.
- When the Schuylkill Valley School District is in session, the pool will be closed on weekdays.
- SMOKE and ALCOHOL-FREE FACILITY

CHANGES DUE TO COVID-19 IN YELLOW

- **Day Passes are NOT available**
- **Daily 3hr block reservations will be required**
- **Pool staff will be cleaning surfaces regularly**
- **Top to bottom deep sanitizing of the bathrooms and all surfaces will be done nightly.**
- **Picnic tables and chairs will NOT be provided**
- **Face masks are strongly encouraged in the restrooms and entrance area**
- **Capacity limits in active zones will be enforced**
 - Baby Pool: 8
 - Shallow End: 25
 - Deep End: 10
- **Snack Bar and pavilion rentals are not available at this time**
- **All patrons and staff must observe and comply with a minimum of 6 feet of social distancing in all directions, including in the water! Families of the same household may sit together with groups no larger than 10 people.**
- **Lost and Found – All items will be discarded daily**
- **No large inflatable pool toys are allowed**
- **Lifejackets are acceptable but cannot be shared amongst different families.**
- **The diving board line will be marked for social distancing. Normal Diving board rules are enforced.**

Leesport Pool 2020 Conduct & Safety Policies

Conduct Policies:

Pool members or guest of members are required to refrain from:

- Disruptive behavior including but not limited to the use of profanity, obscenity, excessive physical contact, inappropriate displays of affection or behaving in a way disruptive to the normal and orderly operation of the pool or pool grounds.
- Wearing bathing attire considered to be inappropriate for a family environment or use of the pool facilities. Proper bathing attire must be worn at all times.
- Verbal abuse or harassment of the pool manager, assistant pool manager, life guards or other pool members.
- Theft of Leesport Pool property, or property belonging to other pool members.
- Possession or use of tobacco by minors under the age of 18 on Leesport Pool property.
- Smoking inside the fenced area of the pool and the pool entrance is prohibited.
- Destroying or defacing Leesport Pool property or property belonging to other pool members.
- Fighting (physical contact meant to do harm to a pool employee or other pool member).
- Diving in shallow areas.
- Socializing with lifeguards or front gate staff while on duty.

Public Health & Safety Policies:

- All patrons must sign a COVID-19 liability waiver upon first entry. The waiver will be valid for the 2020 season
- All children age 3 or under or ANY swimmer not toilet trained MUST wear a swim diaper in the pools. Disposable diapers are prohibited.
- Admission to the pool may be refused to any person having an open wound or any communicable disease.
- Patrons should not enter the pool facility if they show any symptoms of COVID-19, including fever, cough or difficulty breathing
- The facility will follow the guidelines of U.S. Center for Disease Control with regard to fecal incidents, which may require clearing or closing the pool for disinfection.
- The pool area will be cleared for 30 minutes following the sound of thunder or sight of lightning. In the event of a pool closing due to weather conditions, all patrons must leave the facility entirely.

All members are required to review, acknowledge, and adhere to the Pool Opening Safety Plan per the CDC guidelines and the liability waiver.

Leesport Pool 2020 Opening Safety Plan

Social Distancing - Grounds:

Yellow

- Families of the same household may sit together with groups no larger than 10 people and must maintain 6ft of distance from others.
- Patrons may bring their own food and drink, we encourage you to leave your area clean and take your trash with you if possible. This will reduce our staff's exposure to disposal of materials.
- Members are strongly encouraged to wear masks when entering or exiting as well as utilizing the restrooms.
- Snack Bar and pavilion rentals are not available at this time.

Green

- Patrons may bring their own food and drink, we encourage you to leave your area clean and take your trash with you if possible. This will reduce our staff's exposure to disposal of materials.
- Members are strongly encouraged to wear masks when entering or exiting as well as utilizing the restrooms.
- Snack Bar and pavilion rentals are not available at this time.

Social Distancing - Pool:

Yellow

- The pool will utilize 3 active zones
 - Deep End: 10
 - Shallow End: 25
 - Baby Pool: 8
- Remember the baby pool is for babies and toddlers and their parents.
- All patrons and staff must observe and comply with a minimum of 6 feet of social distancing in all directions, including in the water!
- Guards on duty and those in the pool should not wear masks for safety reasons.
- Wrestling and activities that involve bodily contact out of your "family unit" is not permitted.
- No large inflatable pool toys are allowed
- Lifejackets are acceptable but cannot be shared amongst different families.
- The diving board line will be marked for social distancing. Normal Diving board rules are enforced.

Green

- The pool will utilize 3 active zones
 - Deep End: 14
 - Shallow End: 55
 - Baby Pool: 19
- Remember the baby pool is for babies and toddlers and their parents.
- No large inflatable pool toys are allowed

Disinfection:

- Bathrooms will be closed periodically throughout the day to deep clean and disinfect.
- All commonly touched surfaces will be cleaned throughout the day.
- All picnic tables and other tables and chairs are not available for use.
- Please dispose of any masks or gloves or other trash properly.

Announcements and Signage:

- Various signs will be placed throughout our facility addressing the safety guidelines.
- Announcements will be made throughout the day addressing the safety guidelines.
- Copies of this plan will be posted at the pool office.

Important Notes:

- To keep our pool open and to keep our members and staff safe, we are asking that while on the property, you adhere to this plan and cooperate with staff requests.
- **During weekends and holidays 3hr block reservations will be required In Green**
- **3hr block reservations will be required In Yellow**
- **Day Passes are NOT available**
- Please stay home if you do not feel well. If you should not feel well during your visit to the pool, consider notifying a pool manager.
- All staff will be required to answer a health questionnaire and report their temperature before their shift.
- All staff equipment will be disinfected throughout the day.
- There will be NO LOST AND FOUND this year. Anything left behind at the end of the day will be placed in the trash.
- These guidelines are subject to change based on guidelines from the CDC , PA DOH, the Governors Reopening Plan, local mandates, and our changing needs. We will notify members of changes as they occur.
- The Leesport Pool management staff reserve the right to ask any member to leave for non-compliance to these guidelines.
- The Leesport Pool management staff reserve the right to ask any member to leave the property if they show any symptoms of COVID-19, including fever, cough or difficulty breathing.
